


Asus Q534U Hard Disk Replacement

This guide takes you through the removal and replacement of the hard disk.


- iFixit Opening Tool (1)
- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Back Case Removal



- Make sure the device is turned off and unplugged from the charger.
 - Use a T5 screwdriver to remove all 10 screws that secure the bottom cover.
 - Pull off the back cover of the laptop.
 - (i) A pry tool may be needed to pull off the back cover.


Step 2



 Wedge an opening tool under the battery's bundled cable connector, and gently pry the connector up and to disconnect the battery.

Step 3





- Lift up the black tab next to the silver ribbon cable.
- Pull lightly on the blue tabs until the silver cable is free.

Step 4



- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove the 5 marked screws.
- Gently remove the battery.
- ♠ Do not bend or puncture the laptop's lithium-polymer pattery.

Step 5 — Hard Drive





Remove four screws with the Phillips #00 screwdriver.


Step 6





Gently lift the hard disk out using the black tab.

Step 7



- Using a Phillips #00 screwdriver remove the four screws of the metal casing
- Remove the hard disk from the metal casing

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
