
In this tutorial, we will be showing you how to replace the Dell Alienware 13 R2's base panel.


- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Turning Over the PC




- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in Before Working Inside Your

 - Close the display and turn the computer over.

Step 2 — Loosen the screws



 Loosen the captive screws that secure the base panel to the computer base.


Step 3 — Releasing the Tabs



 Using a plastic scribe, gently release the tabs that secure the base panel to the computer base.


Step 4 — Disconnecting the Battery Cable






- Disconnect the battery cable from the battery-cable connector.
- Turn the computer over.

Step 5 — Power Button




 Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds to ground the system board.

Step 6 — Connect the Battery Cable




Connect the battery cable to the battery-cable connector.

Step 7 — Aligning the tabs



 Align the tabs on the base panel with the slots on the computer base and snap the base panel into place.

Step 8 — Tighten the screws



 Tighten the captive screws that secure the base panel to the computer base.
