### INTRODUCTION


In this guide, will be showing you how to remove and replace the Memory Module.

• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Removing the Battery




- Slide the battery release latch toward the side of the computer until it is engaged.
  - Slide the battery out of the bay.
- If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.

#### Step 2 — Removing the Cover



• Turn the computer upside-down, loosen the eight captive screws on the cover and remove the cover.

#### Step 3 — Popping up the Memory Module



- NOTICE: To prevent damage to the memory module connector, do not use tools to spread the memory module securing clips.
- NOTICE: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on the back of the computer).
  - Use your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing clips on each end of the memory module connector until the module pops up.
    - Remove the module from the connector.
- If this is all you are doing Follow Step In Reverse if not Go to Next Step.
