### **INTRODUCTION**

Buttons might tear and get worn out so it is important to replace the buttons.



# **TOOLS:**


- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- JIS #00 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Case



 Wedge a plastic opening tool in between the case.

#### Step 2








- Starting with the bottom left corner, press down on the plastic opening tool to unhook the latches on the inside of the device.
- (i) You have to start with the bottom left and right corners, and then flip the device to over and do the top of the device.


### Step 3



 Once unclipped, separate the back casing from the device.


#### Step 4 — Buttons






Remove the three 5mm JIS #00 screws from the motherboard.

### Step 5



 Unlatch the two clips that hold the motherboard in place.

# Step 6



 Lift the motherboard up and out of the frame.

### Step 7





- Holding the front casing in your hand, push the button panels out of the casing.
- (i) There are two buttons panels: Navigation panel and the Channel Number panel

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
