


INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to replace an old or faulty battery on the Acer Aspire E5-573G.



Step 1 — Optical Drive




- Ensure your device is OFF before beginning this procedure.
 - Unscrew the 5 mm Phillips head screw holding the drive in place.

Step 2




• Pull out the disk drive.

Step 3 — Battery



 Unscrew the seventeen 5 mm
 Phillips head screws from the bottom cover.

Step 4



 Unscrew the three 2.5 mm Phillips head screws underneath the optical drive bay.

Step 5



 Run a pick between the bottom cover and the device around the edge of the laptop and unclip the cover from the rest of the device.

Step 6



- Lift the left side of the bottom cover, but **do not completely remove the cover**, as the speaker is cable is still connected and will be damaged.
- Pull the speaker connector towards the fan to disconnect it from its socket on the motherboard.

Step 7



- Pull the battery connector towards the battery to disconnect it from its socket on the motherboard.
- Remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

Take your e-waste to an <u>R2 or e-Stewards certified recycler</u>.
