

# **Dell Vostro 3360 Hard Drive Replacement**

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
Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Remove the Screw



 Remove the screw that secures the keyboard to the chassis.

#### Step 2 — Prying the Keyboard




 Starting on the right side of the system, use a plastic scribe to pry up the keyboard from the computer.

## Step 3 — Flipping the Keyboard



 Flip the keyboard over and lay it on the palmrest.

## Step 4 — Lifting the Clip




 Lift the clip to release the keyboard cable and disconnect it from the computer.

## Step 5 — Remove the Screw



 Remove the screw that secures the access panel to the computer.

## Step 6 — Remove the Access Panel



 Remove the access panel from the computer.

## **Step 7** — **Display-Hinge Cover**




 Remove the screws that secure the display-hinge cover to the computer

#### **Step 8** — Remove the Display Hinge Cover




 Remove the display-hinge cover from the computer.

## Step 9 — Prying the Rubber Pads




 Using a plastic scribe pry out the rubber pads that cover the front screws on the base cover.

## Step 10 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the screws that secure the palm-rest to the computer.

## **Step 11 — Disconnecting the Board Cable**



 Disconnect the quick launch board cable, the finger print reader cable, and the palmrest cable from the system board.

## **Step 12 — Disconnecting the LED Cable**




 Disconnect the power LED cable and the LED board cable from the system board.

## Step 13 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the screws that secure the palmrest to the front of the computer.

## **Step 14** — Prying the Edges of the Palm-Rest




 Pry along the edges of the palmrest to release the palmrest.

## **Step 15** — Lifting the Palm Rest



 Lift the palm-rest up and away from the computer.

## Step 16 — Hard Drive



 Remove the screws that secure the hard drive to the computer.


 Lift the hard drive to disconnect the hard-drive cable

# Step 18



 Disconnect the hard-drive cable from the hard drive and remove the hard drive from the computer

# Step 19



 Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive and remove the hard drive bracket from it.
