


# Motorola Moto E4 Plus Earpiece Replacement

# TOOLS:

iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1) ESD Safe Blunt Nose Tweezers (1) Spudger (1) T4 Torx Screwdriver (1) Precision Tweezers Set (1)

# 🌣 PARTS:

Moto E4 Plus Battery - Genuine (2) Moto E4 Plus Battery Adhesive Strips -Genuine (2) Motorola HE50 Battery (3) Moto E4 Back Camera (2) Moto E4 Motherboard (1) Moto E4 Earpiece Speaker (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Plate and Battery



• Insert the spudger into the notch on the corner of the phone and lift up to remove the back case.



• Use the <u>T4 Torx Screwdriver</u> to remove the <u>17 3.2 mm screws</u> in the back panel covering the battery.

# Step 3



• Lift up and remove the back panel.




• After removing the back panel, use the spudger to lift and detach the <u>Battery Flux Cable</u> from the <u>Motherboard</u>.

### Step 5




• Wedge the spudger between the battery and the phone to lift the battery up and remove the battery. There will be slight resistance to this but the battery will not be damaged by this. It is just the adhesive tape.

#### Step 6 — Rear Camera




- Use a pair of tweezers to peel up the copper tape that covers the rear camera flex connector.
- Fold the copper tape out of the way.

# Step 7




• Use the flat end of a spudger to pry up and disconnect the rear camera flex cable.



• Carefully remove the rear camera with a pair of tweezers.

# Step 9 — Motherboard



• Use the <u>T4 Torx Screwdriver</u> to remove the <u>2 3.2 mm screws</u> circled in the image.




• Use the <u>Spudger</u> to lift up and detach the <u>Main Flex Cable</u> from the <u>Motherboard</u>.

# Step 11




• Use the <u>Spudger</u> to lift up and detach the <u>LCD Screen Flex Cable</u> from the <u>Motherboard</u>.



 Use the <u>Plastic Spudger</u> to lift up and detach the <u>Signal Flex</u> <u>Cable</u> from the <u>Motherboard</u>. The <u>Signal Flex Cable</u> should still be attached to the body of the phone.

# Step 13



• Use the <u>Spudger</u> to lift up and remove the <u>Motherboard</u> from the phone.

# Step 14 — Earpiece Speaker



• Use the <u>Plastic Spudger</u> to remove the <u>Earpiece Speaker</u> from the phone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
