
Step 1 — Lifting the Mylar




- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in Before Working Inside Your Computer. After working inside your computer, follow the instructions in After Working Inside Your Computer.
- Lift the Mylar to access the memory module.

Step 2 — Popping up the Memory Module









 Use your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing-clips on each end of the memory-module slot until the memory module pops up.

Step 3 — Removing the Memory Module




• Remove the memory module from the memory-module slot.

Step 4 — Lifting the Mylar



• Lift the Mylar to access the memory-module slot.

Step 5 — Align the Notch



Align the notch on the **NEW** memory module with the tab
on the memory-module slot.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
