

Sony Xperia XA Back Cover Replacement

How to take off the back cover on a Sony Xperia XA.

INTRODUCTION

You will need to use a source of heat. You may need to buy adhesive for the reassembly. Make sure the phone is completely powered off before opening the device.



TOOLS:

- Heat Gun (1)
- Suction Handle (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover



- Apply heat on the back surface of the phone.
- (i) Continue to heat the device as needed throughout the replacement process.
- The device can get very hot, so be careful when handling it.

Step 2



 Stick the small suction cup on the bottom half of the back surface of the phone.

Step 3







- With the bottom of the device facing you, lift up on the suction cup handle.
- Use the plastic opening tool around all sides to pry off the back cover.

Step 4









- Pull the back of the phone case away from the device.
- (i) You will hear popping sounds of glue being ripped from the phone.
- (i) You will hear the sound of the back unlatching from the device.
- You will need to apply adhesive or glue along the device to have maximum seal in reassembly.
- (i) RAF antenna may be attached to the back cover upon removal.

Step 5



- Apply heat to the copper RAF antenna.
- This step and the following step only apply if the RAF antenna does not come off when taking the back cover off.

Step 6



Peel back the RAF antenna.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
