INTRODUCTION

Follow this guide to replace a capacitor in a Kicker CXA 3001 amplifier.



TOOLS:

- T10 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Portable Soldering Iron (1)
- 2mm Hex Key (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)

Step 1 — Capacitor



 Remove the five T10 Torx screws from the housing.

Step 2



 Remove the two T10 Torx screws from the faceplate.

Step 3






- Remove the six T10 Torx screws from the bottom.
- Pull off the bottom.

Step 4



Desolder the capacitor and remove.

Step 5



Refer to iFixit's soldering <u>guide</u> to reattach capacitor.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
