


# **Dynex DX-WBRDVD1 Cleaning The Optical Lens**


#### **INTRODUCTION**

Cleaning your optical drive is standard maintenance especially if your movies wont play. Here is how you get to it and clean it properly.



Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1) Microfiber Cleaning Cloths (1)

### Step 1 — Top Cover




• Remove the four 5mm Phillips #1 screws that connect the black outer shell to the silver back of the device.

### Step 2



- Remove the two 5mm screws on the left and right side panels.
  - (i) There is one screw on each side that secures the cover to the body of the device.

# Step 3



- Lift the black cover to a 45 degree angle from the rear of the device and pull the cover away entirely.
- ⚠ Check that the power cord is not preventing the device from opening or closing.


### **Step 4 — Dynex DX-WBRDVD1 Cleaning The Optical Lens**






• To access the optical lens, pull back the optical drive as shown in the pictures located on the two metal rails.

# Step 5





⚠ Clean the optical lens by rubbing gently with a microfiber cloth.
