




INTRODUCTION

In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Memory Modules.

Step 1 — Popping up the Memory Module




- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in <u>"Before You Begin".</u>
- CAUTION: To prevent damage to the memory-module connector, do not use tools to spread the memorymodule securing clips.
 - Use your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing clips on each end of the memory-module connector until the memory module pops up.



Step 2 — Remove the Memory Module


Remove the memory module from the memory-module connector.

Step 3 — Align the Notch



Align the notch on the NEW memory module with the tab on the memorymodule connector.

Step 4 — Installing the Memory Module



- Slide the memory module firmly into the slot at a 45-degree angle, and press the memory module down until it clicks into place. If you do not hear the click, remove the memory module and reinstall it.
- (i) NOTE: If the memory module is not installed properly, the computer may not boot.
