
In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive Assembly.



TOOLS:


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the Screws



- Follow the instructions in "Before You Begin".
- Remove the four screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

Step 2 — Sliding the Hard Drive




 Using the pull-tab, slide the harddrive assembly to disconnect it from the connector on the system board.

Step 3 — Lifting the Hard-Drive Assembly



 Lift the hard-drive assembly off the computer base.

Step 4 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the four screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 5 — Lifting the Hard Drive




 Lift the hard drive away from the hard-drive bracket.

Step 6 — Align the Screw Holes




 Align the screw holes on the harddrive bracket with the screw holes on the hard drive.

Step 7 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the four screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 8 — Placing the Hard-Drive Assembly



 Place the hard-drive assembly in the computer base.

Step 9 — **Sliding the Hard Drive Assembly**



 Using the pull-tab, slide the harddrive assembly into the connector on the system board.

Step 10 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the four screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.
