INTRODUCTION



Step 1 — Change the water regularly.





Step 2 — Store the ice





Step 3 — Remember to set the cleaning cycles





Step 4 — A manual clean also helps




Regular automatic cycles will handle any day-to-day mess and bacteria that may occur. But, those
