



#### Step 1 — CAUTION



- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in <a href="Before You Begin.">Before You Begin.</a>
- AUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- ↑ CAUTION: Hard drives are extremely fragile. Exercise care when handling the hard drive.

#### Step 2 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the four screws that secure the hard-drive assembly.

#### Step 3 — Lifting the Hard Drive Assembly



 Turn the computer over and lift the hard-drive assembly out of the harddrive bay to disconnect the harddrive assembly from the connector on the system board.

#### **Step 4** — **Disconnect the Interposer**



 Pull the interposer to disconnect it from the hard drive.

## Step 5 — Connect the Interposer




 Connect the interposer to the NEW hard drive.

#### Step 6 — Align the Hard Drive Assembly



 Align the hard-drive assembly with the connector on the system board and press the hard-drive assembly into the hard-drive bay until it is fully seated.

#### Step 7 — Replace the Screws



 Turn the computer over and replace the four screws that secure the hard-drive assembly.
