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INTRODUCTION

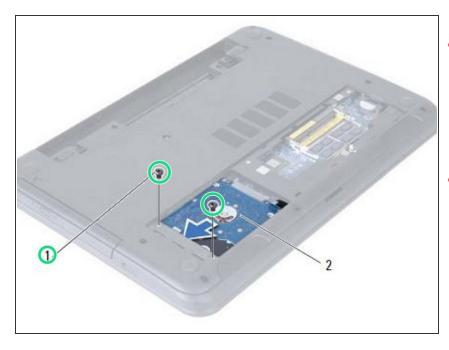
In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard-Drive Assembly.



TOOLS:

• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the Screws



- ★ WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer and follow the steps in "Before You Begin".
- ↑ CAUTION: Hard drives are extremely fragile. Exercise care when handling the hard drive.
 - Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

Step 2 — **Sliding the Hard-Drive Assembly**



 Slide the hard-drive assembly forward to disconnect the hard-drive assembly from the system board.

Step 3 — Lifting the Hard Drive Assembly



 Using the pull-tab, lift the hard-drive assembly out of the computer base.

Step 4 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 5 — Lifting the Hard Drive Bracket



 Lift the hard-drive bracket off the hard drive.

Step 6 — Align the Screw Holes



 Align the screw holes on the harddrive bracket with the screw holes on the **NEW** hard drive.

Step 7 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 8 — Sliding the Assembly



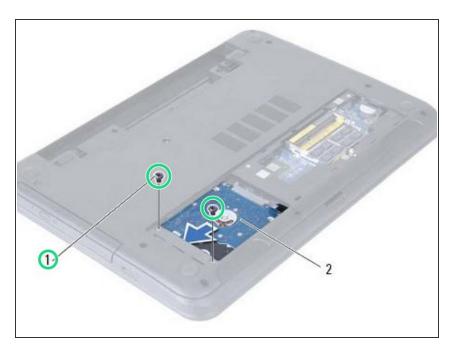
 Slide and place the hard-drive assembly in the hard-drive bay.

Step 9 — **Sliding the Assembly**



 Slide the hard-drive assembly backward to connect the hard-drive assembly to the system board.

Step 10 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.
