

# INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.

# TOOLS:


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• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in "Before You Begin".
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
  - Remove the two screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the system board.



### Step 2 — Sliding the Hard Drive Assembly

 Slide the hard-drive assembly to disconnect it from the system-board connector.

# Step 3 — Lifting the Hard-Drive Assembly



 Lift the hard-drive assembly off the system board.

#### Step 4 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the four screws that secure the hard drive to the hard-drive bracket.

## Step 5 — Lifting the Hard Drive



• Lift the hard drive away from the hard-drive bracket.

#### Step 6 — Placing the Hard Drive




Place the **NEW** hard drive in the hard-drive bracket.

## Step 7 — Replace the Screws




 Replace the four screws that secure the hard drive to the hard-drive bracket.

#### Step 8 — Placing the Hard-Drive Assembly




• Place the hard-drive assembly on the system board.

#### Step 9 — Sliding the Hard-Drive Assembly



 Slide the hard-drive assembly to connect it to the system-board connector.

#### Step 10 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the two screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the system-board.
