INTRODUCTION

Clean the head of the hairdryer, including the vent, to prevent the fan from getting clogged. Debris in the fan may cause a rattling noise or cause the fan to stop working.



TOOLS:

- Paper Towels (1)
- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- Toothbrush (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Optional

Step 1 — Shell



- A Before disassembly, make sure that the device is unplugged.
 - Remove the two 17.83 mm black screws located on the handle.

Step 2




- Separate the shell from the main component.
- Check to ensure each piece is free from debris.

Step 3







- Remove the casing from the heating element.
- (i) For reassembly, reattach the silver casing before the black cover.

Step 4 — Revion 473 Disassembly




 Take the head of the hairdryer and pull the pieces apart.

Step 5



 Remove the black vent from the grey cylindrical piece.

Step 6



- If there is lint in the vent, use tweezers or a toothbrush to extract it from the vent.
- This will keep the fan from getting clogged and malfunctioning.

Step 7





Clean the other black vent with a toothbrush.

Step 8



 Clean these two components with a paper towel.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
