Step 1 — Final Thoughts



- Only a few tools are required to take the whole console apart.
- Once inside, a clean, no-nonsense modular design allows the hard drive, fan, heat sink, PSU, wireless board, and front daughterboard to be easily replaced.
- Fewer interlocking body panels and a simpler clip arrangement make opening this generation of Xbox easier than the original Xbox one.
- Replacing the hard drive will require some difficult hackery to make it serviceable.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
