



Rear camera lens replacement for Samsung galaxy A 40

Repair and replacement for the camera lens of a Samsung Galaxy A 40, advice for the replacement of the lens

INTRODUCTION

- If the camera lens is broken, but you can still take photos and videos.
- You should replace the rear camera lens, because your photos are blurry.
- To start the repair, take out the broken glass shards and place the new lens into the camera bracket.
- Clean the camera bump and re-glue the new lens with double sided tape or two drops of glue.
- This simple repair requires precision because you have to touch the cameras.
- To do the replacement in the best conditions, equip yourself with safety glasses to protect yourself from glass shards in the eyes.

Step 1 — Rear camera lens



- Your Galaxy A 40's lens is broken. Replace it in just a few minutes in order to make good quality images and videos again.

Step 2



- Pull out the little glass shards and be sure not to damage or scratch the camera lenses just underneath.

Step 3



- Pre-glue the new Samsung Galaxy A 40 rear camera lens with double-sided tape or two drops of B7000 glue.
- Position this glass lens in its bracket using straight precision tweezers.

Step 4



- Lightly press on the area to fix the lens.
- Test your rear camera to confirm the quality of your photos and your videos.
- If you are satisfied leave it to dry for an hour.

Bravo! You replaced the lens of your Samsung Galaxy A 40, clean the lens with a microfibre cloth. You can now take pictures and videos normally again.
