INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to close and reseal your Apple Watch Series 4 after disassembly.

TOOLS:

ESD Safe Blunt Nose Tweezers (1) iOpener (1)

Step 1 — Resealing Procedure




- Remove the blue protective film from the adhesive.
 - i To simplify the removal you can lift and cut the blue protective film at one point. Avoid cutting the force touch gasket.

Step 2







- Align the screen and press it down firmly onto the adhesive.
- For best results, apply heat from your iOpener, heat gun, or hair dryer to help set the adhesive.
- After the screen sits in place apply some pressure for a few hours by wrapping the watch with a couple rubber bands, or placing it under a heavy book or two.
