




How to Get Rid of Urine Stains in the Carpet

INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to get rid of urine stains in your carpet immediately. Please follow the instructions and enjoy. You will need 2 dry towels, baking soda, vacuum, water solution, a sponge, and dishwashing liquid.

Step 1 — How to Get Rid of Urine Stains in the Carpet



- Fold a dry cloth or a towel and press it firmly over the stain.

Step 2



- Sprinkle a dash of baking soda on the stain and leave it there for 30 minutes to soak.

Step 3



- Vacuum the baking soda afterwards to remove the residue from the carpet.

Step 4



- Use a one-to-one (1:1) ratio of dishwashing liquid and water to clean the pee stains on the carpet.

Step 5



- Use a sponge to spot the solution lightly on the stain until it is visibly gone.

Step 6



- When the urine is visibly gone, spot with a clean dampened (wet) towel to rinse.

Step 7



- And then use a dry cloth or towel to remove the excess of moisture on the carpet until it's dry.
