TOOLS:

- 6-in-1 Screwdriver (1)
- Large Needle Nose Pliers (1)



PARTS:

• Type 7506 Vehicle Lightbulb (1)

Step 1 — Tail light Bulb




- Open the trunk of the car to access the tail lights.
- Remove the two 5 mm screws holding the panel cover in place.

Step 2



 With a flathead screwdriver, turn the screws half a turn counterclockwise.

Step 3



With plyers, remove the screws.

Step 4







- Pull up the trunk matt and remove it from the corner.
- Pull up the panel by the tab.
- (i) The panel should lift right out.

Step 5







- (i) You will see the light bulb holster.
- Turn the dial in the middle of of the black plastic light bulb holster.
- Pull the holster out of the trunk bay.

Step 6



- Grab the light bulb at the base and twist counterclockwise.
- ↑ DO NOT TWIST THE BULB BY THE GLASS.

Step 7



 Pull out the bulb and repeat the process in reverse order with the new bulb to reassemble.

To reassemble, follow these instructions in reverse order.
