

Sony WH-1000XM4 Ear Pads Replacement

Follow this guide to replace the ear pads on...

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INTRODUCTION

Follow this guide to replace the ear pads on the Sony WH-1000XM4 wireless headphones.

Note: The left and right ear pads are different on this model.

🖌 TOOLS:

Spudger (1)

🌣 PARTS:

X-5001-117-1 - Sony WH-1000XM4 Left Ear Pad (Black) (1) X-5001-118-1 - Sony WH-1000XM4 Right Ear Pad (Black) (1)



Step 1 — Place the headphones speakers-up

- ③ Before beginning any repairs, press and hold the power button on the left ear cup for about 2 seconds until the blue light turns off.
- Place your headphones onto a work surface, ear pads facing up.

Step 2 — Create a gap



• Use your thumb to depress the **LEFT** ear pad near the long outer edge, creating a gap between the cushion and the frame.

Step 3 — Unclip the ear cup



- Insert the flat end of a spudger into the gap you've created, between the edge of the cushion and the frame.
- Pivot the spudger down to unclip the long edge of the ear pad.
 - (i) This may take a considerable amount of force. If the cushion won't click out of place, move your spudger to different points along the long edge.

Step 4




• Repeat the previous step around the perimeter of the ear cup to disconnect the remaining clips.

Step 5 — Remove the ear pad



• Remove the left ear pad.

Step 6 — Reassembly tip



When installing a replacement left ear pad:

- Align the cushion over the speaker and press them firmly together to snap it into place.
- Press around the entire edge of the cushion, making sure all the clips have engaged.

Step 7 — Create a gap



• Use your thumb to depress the **RIGHT** ear pad near the long outer edge, creating a gap between the cushion and the frame.

Step 8 — Unclip the ear cup



- Insert the flat end of a spudger into the gap you've created, between the edge of the cushion and the frame.
- Pivot the spudger down to unclip the long edge of the ear pad.
 When the first clip disconnects, you'll hear an audible clicking sound.
 - (i) This may take a considerable amount of force. If the cushion won't click out of place, move your spudger to different points along the long edge.

Step 9




• Repeat the previous step around the perimeter of the ear cup to disconnect the remaining clips.

Step 10 — Remove the ear pad



• Remove the right ear pad.

Step 11 — Reassembly tip



🗷 When installing a replacement right ear pad:

- Align the cushion over the speaker and press them firmly together to snap it into place.
- Press around the entire edge of the cushion, making sure all the clips have engaged.

Compare your new replacement part to the original part—you may need to transfer remaining components or remove adhesive backings from the new part before installing.

To reassemble your device, follow the above steps in reverse order.
