


# Lenovo IdeaPad Flex 5-1470 Motherboard Replacement

## **INTRODUCTION**

This is a guide for how to replace a Lenovo IdeaPad Flex 5-1470 motherboard. Common reasons to replace the motherboard are because of overheating, power surges, old age or just overuse.

iFixit Opening Tool (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)

## PARTS:


5B20N67526 - Lenovo Laptop Motherboard - Genuine (1) Lenovo Flex 5-1470 and Flex 5-1570 Motherboard (1) Lenovo Yoga 520-14 and Flex 5-1470 Motherboard (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Panel



 Remove all ten 6.6 mm screws with a Phillips #00 screwdriver.





• Use the plastic opening tool to lift up and remove the casing.

## Step 3 — SSD



- Remove the single 3.6 mm screw using a Phillips #00 screwdriver.
- (i) The SSD will pop up on its own after removing the screw.

#### Step 4 — Motherboard



- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove the three screws securing the fan.
- Lift the fan up and out.
- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove the three screws securing the hard drive.
- Lift the hard drive up and out.

#### Step 5




• Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove the single screw securing the Wi-Fi card.

(i) The Wi-Fi card will slightly lift away from the motherboard.

• Pull the Wi-Fi card directly out of its port.

## Step 6



- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to remove the three screws securing the motherboard.
- Gently disconnect the cables and ribbon cables connected to the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
