


# **Dell Optiplex GX620 RAM Replacement**

This guide will show you how to remove the memory modules from a Dell Optiplex GX620.

## **INTRODUCTION**

RAM should be replaced if the computer has memory issues. This is sometimes the case when the computer won't boot, or simply runs too slow for comfort.



# **TOOLS:**

Anti-Static Wrist Strap (1)

#### Step 1 — How to unplug and discharge before repair





Power down your PC and remove the power cord from the back.

#### Step 2






- Press and hold the power button for about 10 seconds, then release.
  - (i) This helps drain any remaining power stored in the capacitors, so that you can safely work on the internal components.

#### Step 3 — Dell Optiplex GX620 Side Panel Disassembly




- With the computer standing upright, firmly pull on the tab at the back of the computer.
- When the side panel pops free, gently pull the panel away from the computer.
- if you have trouble freeing the side panel from the case, you may need to pull the tab a bit harder.

#### Step 4 — Press the clips



 Using the tips of your fingers, press out the securing clips on both sides of the memory modules.

## Step 5 — Remove the memory



 To remove the memory, pull straight up on the module.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
