

#### INTRODUCTION

Acer Aspire - V5-572, V5-572G

Follow this guide if you want to change / upgrade your HDD (Hard Disk Drive) or install SSD (Solid State Drive).

#### TOOLS:

Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1) iFixit Opening Picks (Set of 6) (1)

#### PARTS:

500 GB 5400 RPM 2.5" Hard Drive (1) 1000 GB 5400 RPM SATA Hard Drive (1) 500 GB SSD Hybrid 2.5" Hard Drive (1)

#### Step 1 — Bottom Cover



- i Switch-off the Laptop.
- Remove the seventeen Philips #0 screws.

## Step 2



• If there is a plastic storage tray in the laptop, remove it.

## Step 3







• Starting from the SD Memory Card hole, start prying between the top and bottom cases.

⚠ Use plastic tools to avoid damaging the cover.

Remove the bottom case.

### Step 4



- ⚠ Disconnect the battery immediately for a safer repair.
- Pull the battery connector away from the hard drive to disconnect it.

#### Step 5 — HDD







- Disconnect the SATA Cable from the Mother Board.
- Take out the HDD and remove the SATA cable from it.
- Now you can change / upgrade your HDD.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
