

# **Disassembling Panasonic GU87 LCD Main Board**


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# 🖌 TOOLS:

Tri-point Y1 Screwdriver (1) Tweezers (1) Tri-point Y0 Screwdriver (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1)

#### Step 1 — LCD Cover removal




- Remove the four rubber screw covers from encircled locations.
- Using a #0 tri wing screwdriver, remove the screws previously hidden below the rubber covers.
- If you have difficulties finding this screwdriver, it is commonly sold as a Nintendo Gameboy/Wii screwdriver.

#### Step 2



- Pry the case open using iPhone tool (as shown), fingernails, small flathead screwdriver, etc.
- Be mindful of location and magnitude of applied force, so as not to damage the case.

#### Step 3 — LCD



 Unlock the minor LCD connector by applying bilateral pressure with tweezers, as shown.

## Step 4




- Use fingernails to pry off minor LCD mount, as shown.
- Remove the minor LCD

# Step 5 — Main Board




- Unlock the LCD connectors shown in red boxes on the picture
- Use tweezers as necessary.

## Step 6



- Place finger nails on the connector tab as shown.
- Lift the connector tab up.

#### Step 7



• Pull/pivot the LCD main board as shown in order to remove.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
