INTRODUCTION

Remove the rear panel to access components inside your iPhone 4.

P2 Pentalobe Screwdriver iPhone (1)

iPhone 4 (CDMA/Verizon) Blank Rear Glass Panel (1)

Step 1 — Rear Panel



- A Before you begin, discharge your iPhone battery below 25%. A charged lithium-ion battery can catch fire and/or explode if accidentally punctured.
- Power off your iPhone before beginning disassembly.
- Your phone's rear cover may have two #000 Phillips screws or Apple's 5-Point "Pentalobe" screws. Check which screws you have, and ensure you also have the correct screwdriver in order to remove them.
- Remove the two 3.6 mm
 Pentalobe or Phillips #000
 screws next to the dock
 connector.

Step 2





- Push the rear panel toward the top edge of the iPhone.
- (i) The panel will move about 2 mm.

Step 3



- Pinch the rear panel with your fingers, and lift it away from the iPhone. Alternatively, use a Small Suction Cup.
- ⚠ Be careful not to damage the plastic clips attached to the rear panel.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
