


# Samsung Galaxy Tab Pro 10.1 Rear Facing Camera Replacement

This guide will show how to replace the rear facing camera on the Samsung Galaxy Tab Pro 10.1.




Metal Spudger Set (1)
iFixit Opening Tool (1)
iFixit Precision Bit Driver, Aluminum (1)
Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
Tweezers (1)

### Step 1 — Rear Panel



- ⚠ Be gentle, the front panel is connected to sensitive wiring that may snap if too much pressure is applied.
- Insert a plastic opening tool into the crevice between the screen and the side of the tablet.
- Go around the entire crevice with the plastic opening tool.
- Set aside the separated front and rear panels of the device.

## Step 2 — Rear Facing Camera







• Use plastic <u>tweezers</u> and carefully detach the rear-facing camera from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
