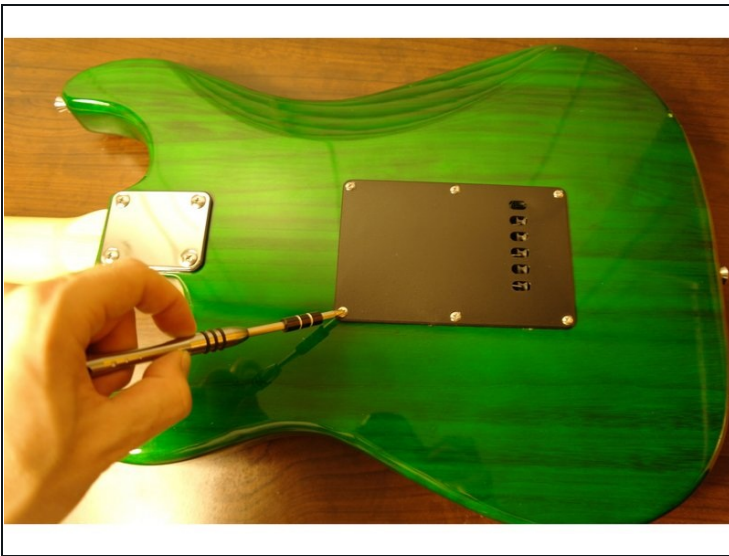
# INTRODUCTION

Replace the pickups on your Squire Strat Guitar.

## TOOLS:

[Desoldering Braid](#) (1)  
[Lead-Free Solder](#) (1)  
[Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)  
[Staples](#) (1)  
[Flush Cutter](#) (1)  
[Solder Sucker](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Pickups



- With a screwdriver, unscrew the back panel screws.
- Remove back panel.

## Step 2



- Unwind and remove the guitar strings.

## Step 3



- With a screwdriver, remove the front body perimeter screws.

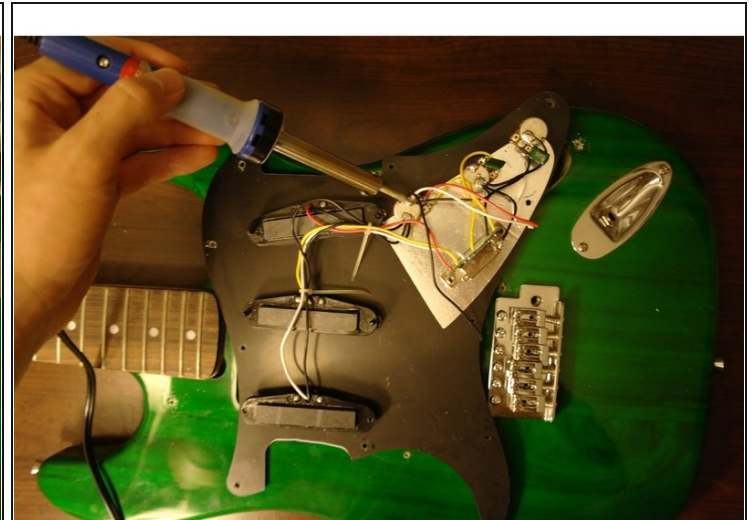
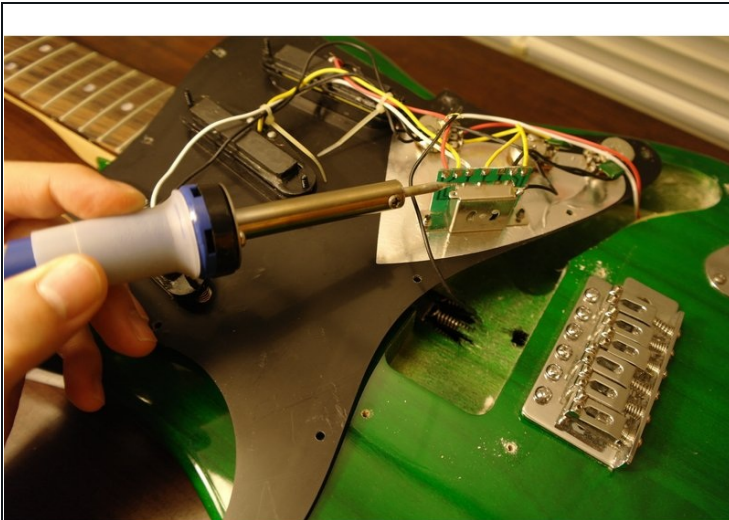


## Step 4



- Carefully lift the panel of the guitar and turn it upside down to reveal the electronic components.

## Step 5



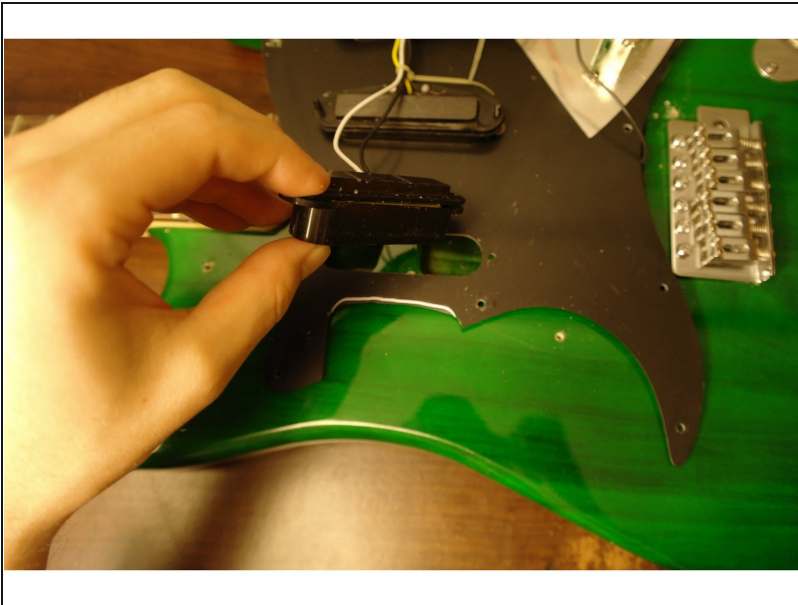
- Using the the soldering iron and the [solder sucker](#) (or the soldering wick), take away any soldering connections of the potentiometers and the five-way switch.

## Step 6



- Carefully flip the back panel to the original position.
- With a screwdriver, unscrew the pickups.

## Step 7



- Remove the old pickups.
