


Black and Decker JS660 Angle Knob Replacement


Screwdriver (1) 3mm Hex Key (or Bit) (1) Base of Black and Decker Jigsaw (1)

Step 1 — Base




• Unscrew the eight screws to open up the jigsaw.

Step 2



- Use a screwdriver to remove the first screws securing the base to the jigsaw.
- Remove the second screw.
- Remove the base of the jigsaw.


Step 3



• With the old jigsaw base off, replace it with the new base by following the steps in the reverse order.

(*i*) Assemble the base on a steady surface.

Step 4 — Angle Knob



- As soon you disassemble the device, you can see the angle knob is not attached to any screws.
- Remove the angle knob from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
