- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — Front Panel



Locate the face-plate eject button.

Step 2





- Press the eject button with your forefinger.
- Remove the face-plate.





- Starting on the top side, pop the front panel frame out.
- Remove the face-plate frame.

Step 4





- Use the plastic opening tool to pry open the tabs.
- Repeat on the opposite side.




Remove the front panel.


Step 6 — Metal Case







• Use the Phillips #0 Screwdriver to remove the screws off of the metal case.








- Carefully separate the top and bottom halves of the metal case apart.
- (i) Do not separate the metal case halves completely.
- Carefully pull the DVD-Drive ribbon cable from the motherboard.

Step 8 — DVD-Drive





Use the Phillips #0 Screwdriver to remove the three screws.



 Lift the DVD-Drive to separate it from the metal case.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
