



EOS Chapstick Repair

This guide will teach you how to fix an EOS chapstick by using a few simple, household tools.

INTRODUCTION

Prior to beginning this fix, you will need to gather necessary materials and supplies. Also take precaution when handling hot, melted chapstick!

TOOLS:


- [melted EOS chapstick](#) (1)
 - [Butter Knife](#) (1)

 - [microwaveable bowl](#) (1)
 - [Microwave](#) (1)
 - [freezer](#) (1)

Step 1 — EOS Chapstick Repair



- Open your broken/melted EOS chapstick.

Step 2



- Use a spudger to scrape out the chap stick pieces.
- Pry out the middle divider.

Step 3



- Place the chapstick pieces into a microwavable bowl.

Step 4



- Melt the chap stick pieces in a microwave for 30 second increments or until completely liquid.
- **CAUTION:** the heated liquid may be hot to the touch.

Step 5



- Pour the liquid chapstick into the top of the EOS container and screw on the divider.

Step 6



- Freeze the liquid in the EOS container for 20-30 minutes or until solid.

Step 7



- Screw the EOS container back together and enjoy your chapstick!

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
