

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This is a step-by-step guide to disassembling and replacing the flash in the Sony Cyber-shot camera.



# **TOOLS:**

- Heavy-Duty Spudger (1)
- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

# Step 1 — Front Casing








First locate the appropriate screws for detachment.

# Step 2



- Remove the five screws shown using a Phillips #00 Screwdriver.
- it is important to put the small screws in a safe location in order to reassemble the casing.

#### Step 3



 Using a spudger, carefully pry open the front casing.


# Step 4






Carefully separate the front casing from the camera body.


#### Step 5 — Camera Flash






Using tweezers, gently pull the ribbon trace out of its housing found on the left side of the flash.

#### Step 6







- Using a spudger, pry the small latch between the lens and the flash open to release the flash.
- Pull the flash away from the camera.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
