

HP Envy x360 m6-aq103dx Bottom Cover Replacement

How to remove the bottom cover of the HP Envy x360 m6-aq103dx

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INTRODUCTION

In order to remove the bottom cover, you will need the nylon spudger and the Phillips 1 Screwdriver Head.



TOOLS:

- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Bottom Cover








- Flip the laptop over to expose the underside.
- Remove the two grip pads with blue plastic opening tool by inserting the tool between the laptop and the pads and slowly lifting up.
- (i) The grip pads are tacky, remove slowly to avoid separating the adhesive.

Step 2



 Remove the two 8 mm Phillips Head screws that were under the grip pads using a Phillip's Head 1 Screwdriver.

Step 3



 Remove the six 5 mm Torx screws using a T5 Torx Screwdriver.

Step 4







- Use the nylon spudger to pop off the bottom cover by inserting it into the heat vent and twisting to the left or right.
- (i) You may hear a slight clicking or popping, but that is normal.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
