


# Acer Chromebook C720-2848 SSD Replacement

## **INTRODUCTION**

Use this guide to replace the SSD of your device.



# **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Cover





Use a Phillips head screw driver to remove the 13 screws in these locations.

## Step 2








• Use a plastic spudger to pry up the bottom cover and remove it.

Re sure to pry along other edges if necessary to avoid damaging the back cover.

## Step 3 — SSD



- Unscrew screw holding SSD card in place.
- Slide out the SSD card towards you to remove it.
- (i) The SSD card is the blue chip on the right connected to the motherboard.
- Be sure to store this screw apart from the others as it is a different length.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
