#### **INTRODUCTION**

If you have a cracked or damaged lens then it's best to replace it so your photos are crystal clear again. Follow this guide to do it yourself!

Before you begin, download the <u>Rescue and Smart Assistant</u> app to backup your device and diagnose whether your problem is software or hardware related.



PARTS:

Tweezers (1)

Motorola Moto G4 Lens (1)

#### Step 1 — Lens





- Place your thumb in the indent located at bottom left corner of the back cover.
- The cover will pop up and begin to lift
- Continue to slide your fingers up the sides to remove the back cover

## Step 2





- Remove the gray plastic surrounding the camera lens with a pair of tweezers.
- i There will be a lot of glue and you may have to pull hard on the plastic piece

### Step 3





- Slide a pair of tweezers under and around the lens to loosen it.
- Pulls the lens towards you to remove.
- i There will be glue under the lens. You may have to pull hard to remove the lens

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
